

AVF FilmGrade V1 • DaVinci Resolve Studio • macOS + Windows

Quick Installation Guide

Install AVF FilmGrade V1 once, then use it in a dedicated creative node whenever you begin a new grade.

01 Unzip your purchase

Download your purchase from Payhip. If it arrives as a ZIP, unzip it and keep the included **.dctl** file unchanged.

02 Open Resolve's LUT folder

In DaVinci Resolve Studio, click the **Project Settings** gear → **Color Management** → **Lookup Tables** → **Open LUT Folder**.

03 Copy the DCTL

Copy the included **.dctl** file into the folder Resolve opened. You may create an "AVF FilmGrade" subfolder to keep tools organized.

04 Restart Resolve Studio

Fully quit and reopen DaVinci Resolve Studio so it indexes the new DCTL.

05 Apply it to a creative node

On the **Color** page, add a serial node. Go to **Effects Library** → **OpenFX** → **DCTL**, drag it onto the node, then choose AVF FilmGrade V1 in the Inspector.

Recommended node order: Balance / Color Space Transform → AVF FilmGrade V1 → Grain and finishing → Output transform. Apply the look after basic exposure and white balance correction.

Important: AVF FilmGrade V1 requires **DaVinci Resolve Studio**; it does not run in the free Resolve edition. For help, email anurag211020022002@gmail.com with your OS, Resolve Studio version, and a screenshot of the LUT folder.
